The meeting was called to order by Bob Nawman, President, with the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag. Bob commented on safe driving, the outstanding performance of the Group Board in all avenues, and the general cooperation from the members of the group.

Dan Karleskint, Vice President and Webmaster was the featured speaker of the day. Dan explained step-by-step how to use the LSV Group Website. How to log in, get your password registered and little tips on transporting that little mouse to where you want it to be! Pages within the website were shown indicating meeting information and minutes, day trips and social events schedule, pictures of those events, legislative information on meetings for the Lincoln Transportation Plan, and many other subjects pertinent to our group. Lillian Nawman, Treasurer-Secretary reported on the current financial position with a checking account balance as of 5-15-05 of \$576.78 with all bills paid. Comment made on the day trips being self-sustaining; and the social events (such as rallies and potluck expenses) being underwritten by the group's treasury.

We currently have 125 households, representing 233 people in the group.
