MINUTES OF THE MEMBERSHIP MEETING OF THE LSV GROUP
Tuesday, September 19,2005

The meeting was called to order by Roger Oldenkamp, Legislative Coordinator stepping in for absent Vice President Dan Karleskint, at 10:00 AM at the Kilaga Springs Presentation Hall. Bob Nawman led the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag.

New members and guests were welcomed and requested to introduce themselves, and state the city they had moved from.

Harry Maker introduced the program speaker, Steve Pleau of Future Ford Roseville. He was accompanied by Joe Hanson, Parts and Service Manager; and Harry Lockwood, Technician. Mr. Pleau focused on the products of the Ford Company, and developments within the industry. A comparison of driving a THINK in a small community as a practical mode of travel, rather than in a metro area was stated. An update of upcoming product lines for 2006 and 2007 was noted.

Mr. Hanson spoke of a Ford THINK Clinic that would be organized for our group very soon, and working with Harry Maker, Maintenance Coordinator of our group to do so. This may be October 8 or October 15 in Lincoln, place of Clinic to be determined. A comment was made that Future Ford is investigating the possibility of having a mobile unit for house calls in the future for its THINK owners. As part of that plan, they may also offer servicing of other LSV brand vehicles.

Mr. Lockwood answered many technical and practical questions from the audience about battery testing and charging, parts available for the THINK, advantages of a new charger and life span difference between a gel battery and an acid battery. Instructions on chargers is forthcoming from Harry Lockwood to our group, and upon its receipt, will be posted on the LSV Website.

Bob Nawman, President, was presented a Ford cap by Joe Hanson, in appreciation for Bob's idea of always starting the membership meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance. Roger Oldenkamp also received a cap.
