### LINCOLN HILLS LSV GROUP MEMBERSHIP MEETING MINUTES Tuesday, January 17, 2006 Kilaga Springs Presentation Hall

The meeting was called to order by Vice President, Dan Karleskint at 10:00 AM. There were 94 present. The Pledge of Allegiance was directed by President, Bob Nawman and followed by introductions of new members and guests.

Lillian Nawman introduced the speaker with a brief bio on her background. The featured speaker was Julie Domenick of Allstate Insurance, with offices in Lincoln and Rocklin. Julie explained the 'recreational packaged policy', the newest concept for LSV insurance, rates, restrictions and other pertinent matters for the policy. A question and answer period followed her talk. Julie was available following the meeting to answer more questions from the membership.

Board member and Rally Master, Harry Maker spoke on the 'Rumors and Myths' concerning the gossip and stories going around the community about the GEM fires. A complete review of occurrences since 2002 to present day indicated that the story has been overblown in the media and TV, and he has had conversations with the Lincoln Fire Chief about the recent fire in a Lincoln home with a GEM. The rumors have been distorted and it was his hope that everyone present knew the background and outcome of this situation. The investigation of the Lincoln fire will soon be revealed.

Gerry Lammerding, Day Trip Coordinator reported on a successful IMAX Theater trip on January 10 with 31 attending. Gerry also mentioned that anyone who had called about attending the lunch at String's Restaurant following this meeting, should be there by 11:45 AM. There were 33 that attended the lunch, and was not a 'sponsored' LSV Group lunch but just a get together for those who wanted to do so.

Diane Maker, Social Events Coordinator spoke of the February 9 Ice Cream Social at KS Social Hall and to get your reservations in. She also showed the LSV Logo apparel available to members, and is waiting to fill more orders before we can submit the total order to the vendor.

Lillian, Treasurer reported there is \$2,379.29 in the Umpqua Bank, Lincoln checking account for our group activities and expenses. All bills are paid and the January 10 day trip was self supporting.

An Association Nominations Committee member, Pat Miller, briefly presented her ideas of how we could help to publicize the upcoming Association board elections by having our members drive their vehicles in a parade type fashion throughout the Lincoln Hills development led by her designated elader. A sign up sheet was passed around and she will contact those who volunteered to be part of this effort. This would occur January 23<sup>rd</sup> from 10 AM to 1 PM.

LSV Group Membership Meeting Minutes

Dan Karleskint, Webmaster presented the insurance survey results by graphs and commented that there were 100 responses to the survey. It was found that 78% of our members drive outside of Lincoln Hills on Lincoln streets. The most popular insurance companies used by members were AAA, Allstate Insurance, and State Farm. Policy costs ranged from \$140 to \$600 depending on whether it was on an auto policy or homeowners policy. Dan will clean up all the loose ends of the survey and issue a final report for the membership.

An Open Forum for the members ensued with good questions and comments from the audience.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 11:25 AM.
