TUESDAY, APRIL 17, 2007

The meeting was called to order by Vice President, Roger Oldenkamp at 10:00 AM. The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Bob Nawman, and a welcome extended to guests and new members by the vice president. There were 88 in attendance.

A video was shown filmed by Elliott Holden, member of the LSV/NEV Group, of the ABC Nightline visit and filming of our group on March 20, 2007 at the Orchard Creek Lodge area. Elliott captured most of the activities and interviews that were made by the ABC interviewer and camera man. It was a very complete story of what occurred that day. A very BIG THANK YOU to Elliott for his expertise in filming this event.

Following that video, we viewed the actual program that was edited and shown from the five hours it took to make the film from the Nightline record. It is a good story of what is occurring in Lincoln with the NEV Plan, and some comments made by members of the LSV/NEV Group. It was a glimpse of what a five hour interview process culminates into a five minute TV segment showing!

Peter Gilbert explained a new committee being formed, for specific information about replacement batteries and insurance information for our members. He asked for volunteers who have had a background and experience in these fields, as well as any members who would like to be of help within this group. Peter will report on progress soon.

The vice president reminded everyone of the April 19th Energy Fair Event being held at the Foskett Ranch School from Noon to 6:00 PM, and requested that the LSV Group members support this by their presence with their NEV's to give parents and attendees at the event to discover what a LSV/NEV is all about.

Our featured program speaker was Gail Williams, joined by Marilyn Barnes of the Lincoln Transit of the City of Lincoln. Gail explained the Dial-A Ride Program, cost and destination points. One must make an appointment a week in advance to be picked up at their home, or one can drive to pick up points for travel to the Galleria and specific spots within Lincoln. Charge is \$2.00 per person for each trip. The Transit employs 7 drivers. You can be picked up from 8:00 AM for the Dial-A-Ride program at your home.

Roger stated that there is a tentative date of August 10 being planned for another GEM Appreciation Day Clinic at McBean Park Pavilion area. Additional information forthcoming as plans are confirmed with GEM.

Harry Maker reported details of the June 3rd Riddle Rally and Pot Luck Lunch, and encouraged the

members to participate.

Lincoln Hills Membership Meeting Minutes

Gerry Lammerding, Day Trip Coordinator reminded everyone of the May 16 Vellejo/San Francisco Ferry Trip and Cable Car Museum sign ups. Also mentioned briefly some of the day trips for the balance of the year, July – October that are now confirmed. There will be a flyer on these trips distributed at the May meeting.

Secretary Lillian briefly mentioned there were 13 openings remaining for the June Ironstone trip and sign ups were being accepted.

A Member Q and A period followed with the following subjects: (1) the current technicians from GEM service department and contacting them for service, (2) battery size and technology being developed for a longer driving range, (3) the use of the Joiner Parkway NEV Lanes, and the posting of the 40 MPH sign at that point, whether it is legal to use the Parkway. Comments made of other cities encouraging their residents to drive a NEV, such as Davis, CA.; Rocklin, CA.; Jackson, CA., and Foster City, CA. The Lincoln Transportation Plan has set a standard of encouraging other cities to take up a similar plan.

There was no further business, and the meeting adjourned at 11:00 AM. The next membership meeting will be held on May 15 at 10:00 AM at Kilaga Springs Lodge Presentation Hall.
