The meeting was called to order by Vice President, Roger Oldenkamp, at 10:00 AM. 87 were present. The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag was led by Bob Nawman. New members and visitors were welcomed and requested to introduce themselves to the audience.

A video was shown of the Lincoln 4<sup>th</sup> of July Parade, videotaped by Elliott Holden. There were 15 LSV/NEV Group members participating in the parade, driving their patriotically decorated LSV's.

Roger reviewed several developments regarding road signage, charging stations and other work being done by the City to improve the Transportation Plan throughout Lincoln.

Larry Schurr reported on his findings about batteries; and Peter Gilbert provided information about his work on insurance policies for NEV's. Their reports were very complete and beneficial for the membership. The importance of changing the controller to match the type of battery was emphasized.

Peter reported the three types of insurance one can secure to include NEV coverage, and explained the differences between the policies. There is a policy specifically for a NEV and is offered by Allstate Insurance. He also noted that anyone that drives over 25 MPH would automatically void their insurance policy because of the clause in the policy that states a 25 MPH restriction.

Paul Ternullo and Larry Schurr are the Service Advisors for the NEV Group, and any member needing answers to basic maintenance questions should give them a call.

Paul gave a comprehensive report on how much electricity one would use when they plug in their NEV; based on factors that include weather temperatures, and constant use of the vehicle. It included charts, ratios and was most educational.

Thank You Larry, Paul and Peter for your informative, thorough reports and reviews for the membership.

Roger stated there are 70 appointments already made for the GEM Appreciation Day being held at Mc Bean Park on August 10. GEM technicians from Fargo, North Dakota will be on hand to inspect all vehicles for a rate of \$25.
