**LINCOLN HILLS LSV/NEV GROUP MEMBERSHIP MEETING MINUTES
TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 18, 2007 KS LODGE PRESENTATION HALL**

The meeting was called to order by Vice President, Roger Oldenkamp at 10:00 AM. The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Bob Nawman. Roger invited all new members to introduce themselves.

Peter Gilbert presented a Certificate of Appreciation to Wayne Davis, a company representative of Home Depot of Lincoln for their participation and cooperation in providing needed electric charging stations and parking spaces, at their place of business in Lincoln. Wayne Davis accepted the certificate for Ed Hoffman, who was unable to be present.

Our speaker for the day was Corporal Bryan Fritsch of the Lincoln Police Department advising us on the "Rules of the Road". Bryan had a power point presentation along with his talk on the California Vehicle Codes that related to LSV/NEV operation. He reviewed making left turns while on Joiner Parkway, differences between golf cart and NEV registrations and their use in the Lincoln community, the rights of a jogger/walker in the street and/or NEV lanes. Bryan answered many member's questions following his talk. It was a very interesting review of 'the rules of the road'.

Paul Ternullo included new information about the ZEV (zero emission vehicle) which will become effective in the future, and how it relates to our responsibility to secure a decal for a one time charge of \$17. He encouraged everyone in the group to secure the decal, for it will relate to electric charging stations and for designated parking spaces.

There were applications for the ZEV decal on the table outside of the hall available for all to take.

The group was reminded to call the following members regarding specific information or help on their NEV. GEM – Larry Schurr. THINK – Paul Ternullo.

Peter Gilbert reported on the latest battery findings. Duncan Automotive in Lincoln can obtain batteries for you and do the installation for a reasonable cost. They have access to all types of batteries, both acid and gel cells. This would provide a very convenient spot for members to obtain service at a Lincoln location.

Peter also reported that each future membership meeting would include one speaker from various insurance companies regarding LSV/NEV insurance plans, and how to determine what type of insurance you should have for your vehicle. Many insurance companies have been asked to participate.

The next part of our meeting brought forward three different distributors representing new NEV vehicles into the marketplace. They were:

Ryan Kugel of Elektrik MotorSports of Loomis. He will be offering service on GEM's, and house calls are available at a cost of \$75. Call Ryan at 916/652-2222. A 15% discount is being offered to LSV members who wish to buy batteries from him.
