

**LINCOLN HILLS LSV/NEV GROUP MEMBERSHIP MEETING MINUTES
TUESDAY, March 18, 2008 KS LODGE PRESENTATION HALL**

The meeting was called to order by Vice President Roger Oldenkamp at 10:00 AM. New members/guests were asked to introduce themselves.

Roger introduced our guest speaker, Julie Dominick from Allstate Insurance. Julie talked about Allstate's efforts in trying to figure out how to insure our vehicles. They initially insured them under a recreational vehicle policy. The City of Lincoln then changed their policy as to where we could drive our vehicles. So, Allstate changed the insurance to a "special auto" policy. This policy will trigger an electronic filing of our registration to the DMV. Insuring the electric vehicles has been a challenge to the industry as they try to come up with a product to fit all aspects. Allstate receives calls from dealerships and others on this subject. If we have a recreational policy with Allstate they will grandfather that into the "special auto" policy. She spoke about the various options, such as collision, medical, un-insured and under-insured and also bodily injuries, etc. She indicated that good driving and mileage counts into the equation. AARP discounts are not available at this time. Also, it is not necessary to have your car and home with Allstate in order to get the insurance for the NEV. We should not insure the vehicle on our homeowner's policy. Q&A: Julie answered the numerous questions from our members.

Paul Ternullo – Special Projects: There will be a special study on street & turf tires. Paul is looking for assistance to work on the study of sources and prices of these tires.

Gerry Lammerding – Group Activities: Gerry went over the various day trips.

Dan Karleskint: New Officers – Re-election will be in September and the two year term is up for the President, VP and Treasurer. Extended an invitation to the group that if they have an interest in any of these positions they should come to a Board Meeting to observe

Roger hopes to have a representative from the DMV as guest speaker at the April meeting.

Roger also brought up the California's alternate fuel rebate program. A new GEM rebate is \$1,300. This would be if you bought one between 5/24/07 and 3/31/09. Can go to www.fuelingalts.energycenter.org \$1.8 million is allotted for the program, and once the money runs out it's done. One member said there seemed to be a problem because they want you to buy an extended warranty? Caution - do the research.
