

**LINCOLN HILLS LSV/NEV GROUP MEMBERSHIP MEETING MINUTES  
TUESDAY, APRIL 15, 2008 KS LODGE PRESENTATION HALL**

The meeting was called to order by Vice President Roger Oldenkamp at 10:00 AM. New members/guests were asked to introduce themselves.

Our guest speaker was Jacqueline Gonzalez, Licensing & Registration for the DMV.

Jacqueline does area drives for golf carts and NEV's. She explained an "area drive" is done for someone who has medical restrictions. DMV wants to know where you live, where you want to drive and also time of day, speed limits, side street routes, etc. Driving would be limited to no more than 5 miles, no driving at night, etc. This would result in giving the person a restricted license. Maximum length for this license is 2 years. Each time there is a renewal she would come out and ride with the person and give a test. She also discussed licensing age 70+ - would need to take written test and possibly driving test. Be sure to ask questions about registration when buying an NEV. DMV looking into concerns about golf carts vs. NEV. She said that she would send an email with the various criteria to distinguish between a golf cart and NEV. ZEV stands for zero emissions vehicle.

Gerry and Lillian talked about day trips: June 24<sup>th</sup> Tahoe trip and April 30<sup>th</sup> Empire Mine Historic Park.

Roger reminded the group about re-election of Pres., VP & Treas. in September. We want to see members getting involved. He invited anyone interested in possibly running to attend our next Board Meeting.

Charisse gave a brief financial summary. Board is looking at spending some of our funds. Also, we have approximately 330 members.

Open Forum: Paul mentioned that he has 5 volunteers to work on NEV tire information and survey. May be presenting findings at the June membership meeting.

Roger mentioned that GEM Corp. hired a production company and was going to film an informational video about the GEM. He will send email as to when that would be for anyone interested in participating.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 11:30 PM. There were 91 members in attendance. The next LSV/NEV membership meeting will be Tuesday, May 20, 2008 at 10:00 AM at KS Lodge Presentation Hall.
